Recommendations for 2013 – 2015 Work Plan

1. Watershed Conservation, Restoration, and Enhancement

- Maintain, enhance, and restore function in the streams and estuaries of the lower Rogue River watershed.

2. Outreach and Education

- Provide opportunities for community members to learn about natural resources and to participate in activities to benefit watershed health.

3. Water Quality and Quantity

- Assess and monitor water quality and quantity, and promote user participation in sustainable ecological practices and methods.

4. Community Sustainability

- Promote strategies that produce a sustainable, natural resource-based economy.
