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Project Location

The project site is located approximately 2.5 miles south of Langlois on a private ranch. The site address is 47404 Floras Lake Loop Rd., Langlois, OR 97450

Legal Description: T31S R15W S9SE

Project Scope

The project consists of installing an 89-foot railcar bridge for crossing livestock and small farm equipment and constructing two large wood structures for instream/streambank restoration. Construction specifications will be provided at the site show (see below), but general activities will include:

- Construction of compacted rock abutment pads and ecology block abutments
- Placement of riprap to abutments and pads from scour
- Construction of rocked bridge access ramps
- Placement of an 89-foot railcar bridge over Willow Creek
- Excavation of keyway trenches for log placement
- Placement of whole and partial logs in excavated trenches (a machine with an attachment that can grab and swivel logs is highly preferred)
- Backfilling of keyway trenches with soil and rock

Project Timing

Tentative start date is August 15, 2022; however, this is tentative on acquiring the necessary permits and clearances. The instream work period ends September 30, 2022; no instream work can occur after that date without an extension from ODFW.

Site Show

A **mandatory** site show will be held on-site at **3pm, Wednesday, June 22, 2022**. Meet at the barn located at the site address. All project activities will be reviewed in the field, which will take approximately 2 hours. **Failure to appear at the site show will bar you from bidding on this project.**
